Sunday, February 8, 2009

Dog Sledding Adventure

Experience an unforgettable backcountry journey behind a team of energetic and loveable Alaskan Racing Huskies. You will assist your professional dog sled musher in hitching and harnessing your dog team while learning about the culture of this amazing Northern sport. Includes approximately 2 hour dog sled ride.

\$150 per person (2 per sled, transportation via the local bus route to Gunnison)

Cross Country Skiing Excursion

On this excursion you will trek along a 50 km groomed trail, meandering through the outskirts of Crested Butte. Ski along the East River around Peanut Lake, through coniferous forest overlooking town or along the base of Crested Butte Mountain.

Monday, February 9, 2009

Snowshoeing

Every day is a new adventure on this guided tour. Snowshoe along the East River around Peanut Lake, through coniferous forest overlooking town or along the base of Crested Butte Mountain.

Come experience the joy and excitement of fresh, dry and untracked Colorado powder downhill skiing with a local, experienced back country guide. There is a wide variety of terrain from the long and involved peak descents to short laps in powder filled glades.

Tonight is a full moon. You will ride a snow cat to the top of the Red Lady Express and embark on a 2 1/2 hour moonlit snowshoe tour of the mountain ending back at the base.

Back Country Cross-Country Skiing Experience

Experience the joy and excitement of fresh, dry and untracked Colorado powder cross-country skiing with a local, experienced back country guide. Enjoy the pristine backcountry excursions through the Colorado wilderness to old deserted mining towns.

Sleigh Ride & Dinner

Enjoy the serenity of snow-capped peaks as the sun sets on another day. Nestle under a warm blanket while an open sleigh pulled by a snowcat takes you two miles up the mountain to Rustica Italian Restaurant in Paradise Warming House. Once there, you will enjoy a gourmet dinner in spectacular surroundings. This event has a 25 person maximum per trip with a total of 2 trips. The trips will not be at the same time, therefore, those on the first sleigh will not be dining at the same time as those on the second sleigh.)

Historical Walking Tour

Crested Butte is famous for both its history and its architectural character. In 1974, the entire Town was designated a National Historic District. The Historical Walking Tour of Crested Butte, led by the Crested Butte Mountain Heritage Museum, will visit 42 buildings dating from the early 1880s. Many are sagging and weather-beaten from surviving over a century of harsh mountain winters, and all stand proud as exceptional examples of America's great past. This walking tour will take place in the morning and end just prior to lunch. Lunch will be on your own in downtown Crested Butte and allow participants to join the art tour in the afternoon.

Art Tour of Crested Butte

Crested Butte has more than half-a-dozen art galleries located primarily in the center of Town. These galleries display works by dozens of local artists as well as artists of international renown. A leading Crested Butte artist will guide a personal tour of these galleries where ISFR visitors will learn about and view our wealth of talent in virtually every art medium. This tour will take place in the afternoon, allowing participants time for morning skiing and lunch or to take the Historical Walking tour.
